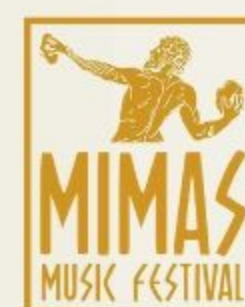

I received a scholarship as part of my winner's award to study with Professor Jeremy Wong for the Helsinki Masterclass. It took place from 12/30/20 until 1/3/21. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, travel was neither safe nor possible, so we met virtually on zoom for our lessons. I can easily say that the experience was well worth the effort, and I gained so much from Professor Wong's expertise. Each of the five lessons was designed with a specific theme and teaching goal in mind. Professor Wong introduced each learning point with an overarching musical theme illustrated by specific passages in the piece. We reviewed ideas such as sound, musical organization, semantics, and more. He was a great communicator and emphasized the mental component of musicianship in addition to teaching me how to physically produce the sounds I wanted.

Professor Wong was also very accommodating about scheduling as we were in very different time zones, and he worked with me even over the holidays. He was personable and compassionate and made the experience so easy to arrange. I have gained so much knowledge through this week of master classes, and it makes me feel more excited than ever to continue practicing so I can begin to implement these new skills in my playing. I am very grateful for the experience."

It was the very 1st online International Competition for me and the result was beyond my expectation. Thank you World Piano Teacher Association Finland who motivate young pianists to strive for more and improve our performance skills in the midst of the pandemic and quarantine life.

I was awarded two scholarships, to partially cover the course fees of the Weimar Intensive Piano Course "Transformation of Mastery" by Prof. Elena, which I hope I can go there after this pandemic is over; as well as a partial scholarship to Naples International Masterclass with Prof. Giuseppe Devastato. The lesson with Prof. Devastato was extremely helpful and it was easy to learn from him. We work on the details of my piece, Chopin's Waltz Op. 64 no. 2, which he listened to every phrase of music I play, and taught me not only techniques but also to musicality alongside his singing. He also fixed my wrist position and movement for good sound production. He is a good musician, with a keen sense of humor, and he has his own way to explain to make the lesson easier for me.

I would like to thank WPTA Finland, Prof. Devastato, and my piano teacher in Yudistira Music School for believing in me. I am looking forward to participate in the next WPTA Finland Competition.
