Megumi Maekawa (Megumi Margaret Kenevan), daughter of an American father and Japanese mother, was born in 2005 and grew up in Tokyo, Japan. She graduated from the junior music academy affiliated with Japan's Toho College of Music (2004-2019, taught by Yuko Mitsuyasu) and is currently a student at Futaba High School in Tokyo. Megumi studies piano under the primary tutelage of Yukio Yokoyama. She has participated in several of Japan's most well-known music festivals and has attended many master classes led by internationally renowned pianists; including Andrzej Jasinski, Cyprien Katsaris, Katsurako Mikami, Nobuhito Nakai, Ichiro Nodaira, Piotr Paleczny, Bruno Rigutto, Hibiki Tamura and Ayako Uehara. She has finished at the top of many Japanese domestic and international competitions, and her recent awards include gold (High School category) and silver (Solo Artist category) medals in the 2021 Chopin International Piano Competition in Asia, the Absolute Award in the 2022 WPTA Finland international piano competition (Senior section), 1<sup>st</sup> prize in the 2022 Concurs Internacional de Piano On-line Chopin Sessions Felanitx (Age group 15-18), Grand Prize in the 2022 Pacific Stars International Piano Competition (Young Artist category), Grand Prize in the 2022 Irvine Conservatory International Music Competition (Category E 17-18), 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize in the LISMA International Music Competition (Category A 17-27) and 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize in the 2022 San Francisco International Piano Competition (Professional category, Young Artist).

Lennis Hoi Shing Cheng was born in 2012 and raised in Hong Kong, started playing piano at the age of five. When he was eight years old was admitted to Junior Music Program of Hong Kong Academy for Performance Arts (HKAPA) with major study of piano, and currently a lower school student of Harrow International School Hong Kong. Lennis had the first international performance at Polish National Radio Symphony Orchestra (NOSPR) in Poland when his age of nine. He received numerous first prizes in the local and Asia piano competitions, including the 1st Prize at Hong Kong International Music & Arts Festival 2019; the 1st Place at Asia Music Competition for Young Artists Busan, Korea; the 1st Prizes at The 8th & 9th Hong Kong International Youth Performance Arts Festival; the 1st Place at The 14th Asia Pacific Outstanding Youth Piano Competition; the Winner Award at Wien International Young Musicians Music Competition of 2022; and the Champion Award at The 74th Hong Kong Schools Music Festival. Furthermore Lennis was also awarded excellent prizes in the international competitions in 2022; including the 1st Runner-up at Chopin Avenue International Piano Spring Competition; the 1st Prize Award with 99.75 mark at Four Notes International Piano Competition; the Silver Award at The 8th Singapore Raffles International Music Festival Virtual 2022; and the Absolute Award with scholarship prize at The 4th WPTA Finland International Piano Competition.
