Nino Chirakadze (Georgia)

Famous Georgian Pianist, Professor at the V. Sarajishvili Tbilisi State Conservatoire, She graduated the P. Tchaikovsky Moscow State Conservatoire under Professor Y. Flier (1977).

Her successful participation in such competitions as the Vienna da Motta International Music Competition (1968), the Geneva International Music Competition (1977) brought her recognition.

From 1977 up present days N. Chirakadze has been carrying out intense teaching activities at Tbilisi State Conservatoire (Chamber ensemble class, major piano) as well as the Z. Paliashvili Central Music School (Tbilisi).

As a member of the jury she is often invited to prestigious national as well as international competitions among them Tbilisi International Piano Competition, pre-selection competitions for "Alessandro Casagrande" International Piano Competition (held in Saratov), The International Johann Sebastian Bach Competition (held in Riga), The Ferruccio Busoni International Piano Competition (held in Sverdlovsk).
