DATES AND PLACE:

 The second edition of the Contest for Young Performers Universidad de Colima - Petrof will take place in Colima city, capital of the state of Colima, Mexico, in-person, from November 23 to 27, 2021.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. The competition is open to musicians of any nationality, according to the following disciplines and age categories:

- 2. The competition will be held in one round, live and open to the public. The participants will present the following **REPERTOIRE**:
 - Two or more works of different styles, that best reflect their technical and musical abilities.
 - The works must belong to the genre of formal classical music and must be published. Each participant must have a copy of their scores ready for the secretary of the jury, if required.
 - The works or movements must be performed completely, memorized and without repeats (except minuets and scherzos). In case of sonatas or suites, one or more movements may count as a single work.
 - Piano duos may use sheet music, but page-turners are not allowed on stage. This edition of the competition is only open for duos of one piano four hands (not for two pianos).
 - Category B and Voice. Maximum duration: 20 minutes.
 - Category A. Maximum duration: 15 minutes.
 - Debut category. Maximum duration: 10 minutes.
- Participants in the disciplines of STRINGS, WINDS and VOICE must come with their own accompanying pianist. In case of requiring a local accompanist, the organizing committee can provide contact information, with the understanding that communication and subsequent agreements with the accompanist are responsibility of the participant.
- The jury will be comprised of musicians of recognized prestige. Their vote will be final. If any participant is a student of a member of the jury or has been so during the three years prior to the competition, that jury member will refrain from qualifying the participant.
- Awards: First, second and third prizes will be awarded in each category and discipline. Awards include cash prizes, gifts, and diplomas. The jury reserves the right not to award any of the prizes.
- 6. Registration deadline: October 25, 2021.
- At the end of the competition rounds in each discipline and category, the names of the participants selected to play in the **Winners Concert** will be announced. The **Winners Concert** and the **Awards ceremony** will take place on Saturday, November 27 at the **University Theater Coronel Pedro Torres Ortiz**. The final results (first, second and third places), will be announced at the **Awards Ceremony**.
- Participants will be responsible for covering the application fee, as well as their travel, lodging and food expenses during the competition.
- APPLICATION: all candidates must send the following documentation by e-mail to iuba@ucol.mx
 - Application form fully completed.
 - Birth certificate or any other official ID document that proves the age of the participant.
 - A letter of recommendation from your current or recent teacher, or any professional musician.
 - Photograph of the participant, in good resolution.

Piano duos: send your documentation together, but each member must attach their application form and official ID document; the photographs can be individual or together.

Please send all the files in a **single email** and indicate in the **subject** "COMPETITION 2021" and the name of the candidate.

- 10. Application fee (non-refundable): \$ 400 MXN for soloists or \$ 600 MXN for piano duets (per ensemble). The information for deposit / transfer will be sent once the application documentation has been received. To be fully registered as a participant, it will be necessary to present **proof of payment** or send it to the same email.
- 11. To receive their award, winners must attend the awards ceremony and perform at the final concert.
- **12.** The events of the competition may be recorded and broadcast in the media, without any remuneration for the participants.
