Aleksandra Horvat, a flutist, completed her elementary and secondary music education in her hometown of Zrenjanin. She continued her studies at the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad under the guidance of Prof. Marian Egic. She has participated in numerous masterclasses led by renowned flutists such as Irena Grafenauer, Felix Renggli, János Bálint, Christine Gangelhoff, among others. Since 2000, she has been teaching flute and chamber music at the "Isidor Bajić" Music School in Novi Sad, receiving several awards as an outstanding pedagogue. She serves as a jury member at international and regional competitions and has performed extensively in solo concerts as well as in flute trios and quartets. She has designed and presented music programs title "With the Sound of the Flute and Piano through Domestic Musical Creativity" (2022/23) and "An Evening of Works by Ante Grgin - Works for Flute" (2024), both supported by Sokoj, which were performed in concerts in Zrenjanin, Sremska Mitrovica, Zemun, Novi Sad, and Belgrade. As the founder of the association MuzikAkcija, she organizes international music camps and instrumental-vocal workshops. After intensive training in Japan under the auspices of the Pearl company, she earned the title of certified technician for Pearl flutes.
