

IGOR DALAGIJA (SERBIA)

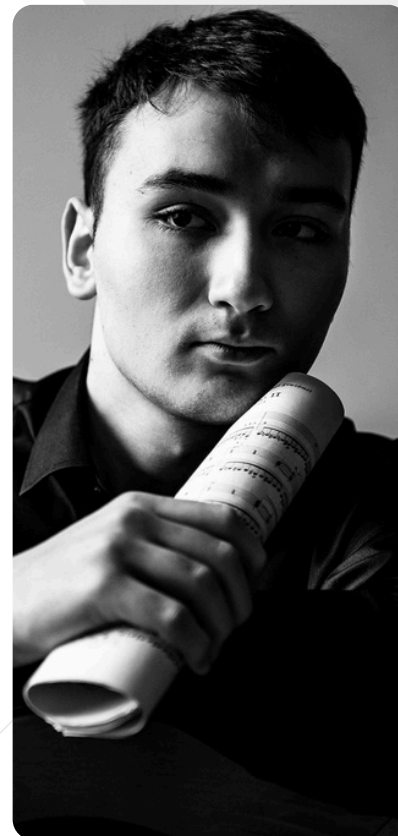
Academy of Arts (Novi Sad)
