WPTA Austria International Piano Competition 2026



The **WPTA Austria International Piano Competition 2026** marks the first edition of this new artistic platform, welcoming **pianists of all nationalities up to the age of 34**. Entirely **online** in its preliminary stage, the competition offers a modern and accessible format while maintaining the highest artistic standards.

Laureates will be invited to Hohenems, Austria, to present themselves in the Gala Concert and Prize Ceremony at the historic Markus-Sittikus-Saal — a stage that connects today's pianists with Austria's timeless musical tradition.

General Provisions

- Open to pianists of all nationalities up to the age of 34.
- The competition is held *entirely online* through *video submissions*.
- Laureates will be invited to Hohenems, Austria, to perform in the Gala Concert and attend the prize Ceremony at the Markus-Sittikus-Saal on 22 March 2026.

Categories

- Category A: 7–10 years old 5–10 minutes
- *Category B:* 11–13 years old 10–15 minutes
- *Category C:* 14–17 years old 15–20 minutes
- *Category D*: 18–24 years old 20–25 minutes
- Category E (Artist Category): 25–34 years old 25–30 minutes

Note: For Categories D and E, participants must present works from at least **two** contrasting styles/periods. All works must be performed from memory.

Programme / Repertoire

Repertoire is free choice within the indicated time limits. Participants are encouraged to present a **varied program** that showcases both **technical mastery** and **musical depth.**

Video Recording Guidelines

- Each piece must be recorded in one single take no editing or splicing is allowed.
- The performer's *hands and face* must be *clearly visible* throughout the recording.
- Use a *fixed camera angle* with *good lighting* and *sound quality*.
- Performance should be recorded in *horizontal format*.
- Videos must be uploaded to **Youtube or Vimeo** (public or unlisted).

Application

Applications must be submitted *online* via the official form at www.wpta.info/austria. Each application must include:

- Completed online application form
- *Video recordings* (YouTube or similar links)
- Short Biography (maximum 150 words)
- One recent Photograph (high quality, suitable for publication)
- **Proof of age** (passport or ID copy)
- **Proof of payment** of the application fee

Application Fees (non-refundable):

Categories A & B: €80
Categories C & D: €90
Category E (Artist): €100

Application Deadline: 20 January 2026

Jury

The *jury* will consist of *internationally recognized pianists and pedagogues* appointed by WPTA Austria. The jury's *decisions are final* and cannot be appealed. Jury members may not vote for their own students.

Prizes

The following **prizes** will be awarded:

• Main Prize (Overall Winner): Awarded to one performer selected across all categories by the jury. Gala Concert performance and Prize Ceremony in Hohenems, WPTA IPC Application Fee Waiver, WPC Registration Fee Waiver, WPTA Lifetime Membership, Official Diploma.

Category Prizes (Categories A-E): Each Category will have its own winners:

- 1st Prize: Gala Concert performance and Prize Ceremony in Hohenems.
- 2nd Prize: Gala Concert performance and Prize Ceremony in Hohenems.
- 3rd Prize: Gala Concert performance and Prize Ceremony in Hohenems.
- Special Prize Austrian Composer Award: For the best interpretation of a work by Franz Schubert or another Austrian composer (Mozart, Haydn, Bruckner, Berg, etc.). The winner will receive a special diploma.

• Honorable Mentions may be awarded at the discretion of the jury.

Certificates

All participants will receive *official digital certificates*. Laureates who perform in the Gala Concert in Hohenems will be awarded *printed diplomas* during the celebrations.
