Yinglun Wong, a young pianist from Hong Kong, is currently pursuing an Artist Diploma in Piano Performance at the Royal College of Music in London, supported by the Dennis and Sylvia Forbes Scholarship. He studies under Professor Dorian Leljak.

Yinglun has won numerous prestigious awards in international piano competitions, including the UNESCO World Chinese Arts Festival Piano Competition, the Singapore Asian Stars of Tomorrow Competition, the Hong Kong-Asia Piano Open Competition, the "Ibiza" International Piano Competition in Spain, the G-Clef International Music Competition in South Korea, the WPTA IPC World Piano Competition, the De Bach au Jazz International Piano Competition in Greece, the Siena International Piano Competition in Italy, and the PSIPC International Piano Competition in the United States. Recently, his remarkable performances have won him the Solo Competition First Prize at the Brescia Music Festival in Italy, First Prize at the WPTA Finland International Piano Competition, First Prize at the LOML International Piano Competition in London, First Prize at the Singapore International Music Competition, and double championships in the Concerto and Professional Artist categories at the GOCAA International Piano Competition in the United States.

Yinglun Wong has performed solo recitals at esteemed venues including Shenzhen Concert Hall, Nanshan Cultural and Sports Center, Shenzhen Huaxia Arts Center, Xiamen Wuyuanwan Concert Hall, Amaryllis Fleming Concert Hall in the UK, Bösendorfer Hall in Salzburg, Salvator Church in Aachen, Germany, as well as in the USA, Spain, and Italy. He has frequently collaborated with the Guangzhou Youth Symphony Orchestra and the Xiamen Philharmonic Orchestra, performing with renowned conductors such as Renchang Fu, Tianji Lin, and Ming Liu, receiving widespread acclaim. Additionally, he has collaborated with orchestras in countries such as Poland, Germany, and the United States.
