



Martin Lysholm Jepsen, born in Copenhagen in 1966.

Martin Lysholm Jepsen graduated from the Royal Academy of Music in Aarhus in 1992 after studies by professor Bengt Johnsson and Docent Aino Gliemann. He continued as aspirant at the Lithuanian Academy of Music from 1992-1994 in the class of Professor Veronika Vitaite. Martin took part in several masterclasses and private lessons by Lazar Berman, Eugen Indjic and Gunter Ludwig. Martin Lysholm Jepsen gave numerous concerts in Denmark and abroad as soloist and accompanist.

In 2001 he founded the Gradus Piano School in Aarhus for young piano talents. At Gradus Martin educated some of the most promising danish pianists, preparing them for further professional studies at acknowledged academies in Berlin, Dusseldorf, Helsinki, Vilnius, Vienna, and at the Lake Como Academy. The Gradus students appeared succesfully in many concerts as soloists and with orchestras in Denmark and abroad. They won more than 300 topprizes in national and international competitions. Many of them are now having a comprehensive career as soloists, chambermusicians, teachers and organizers.

Since the summer 2016 Martin Lysholm Jepsen has been appointed as teacher at the Royal Academy of Music in Aarhus and he is director of the Junior College at the same Academy. Since 2018 Gradus Junior College was supported by the Augustinusfoundation and cooperation with the Royal Academy in organizing common concerts and masterclasses for all their piano students.

Martin gave masterclasses and lectures on the theme “Basic principles for building a strong and healthy piano technique” in several countries and he is regularly in the jury of competitions in Sweden, Poland, Lithuania, Iceland, Italy and Denmark. Martin Lysholm Jepsen was in board of EPTA-DK since 2000 and he is the founder and artistic director of the Gradus International Piano Festival in Musikhuset Aarhus, presenting young talents and master pianists annually from 2013-2020.
