



Pianist **Peter Máté** was born in Czechoslovakia, but he has been living in Iceland since 1990. Peter completed his master's degree from the Academy of Music in Prague. During his student years he won many prizes in his home country and later in international competitions, such as in Vercelli and Enna in Italy in 1986 and 1989. Peter has performed in solo and chamber concerts (Reykjavík Trio, Kópavog's Chamber Trio, etc.) in many European countries and in the United States.

Peter is a professor at the Iceland University of the Arts, but also teaches piano at the Reykjavik College of Music. He has premiered many Icelandic piano and chamber works and has lectured on Icelandic piano music. Peter's complete recording of John Speight's piano works was chosen as Record of the Year at the Icelandic Music Awards 2021. Peter has been a guest teacher at many foreign conservatories. (Budapest, Brussels, Chicago, Graz, Helsinki, Lyon, Oslo, Poznan, Riga, Stockholm, Tallinn, etc.).
