Washburn University / KBL Piano, LLC (Topeka, Kansas)

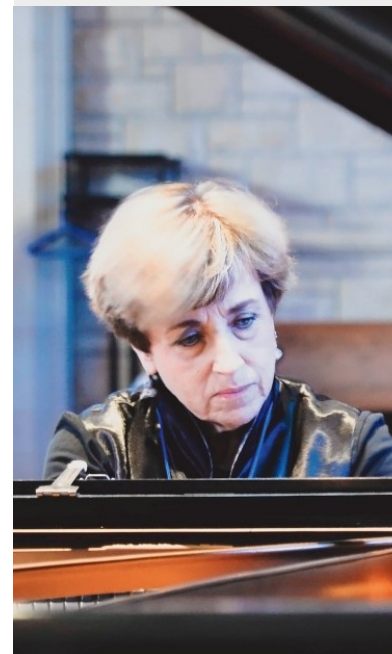

She has enjoyed a long, successful career as a performing artist, master clinician and adjudicator, adjunct professor, church musician, and public-school music educator. She currently holds a position as Adjunct Professor of Applied Piano at Washburn University of Topeka (Kansas). Dr. Baker-Lampe enjoys Permanent Professional status as a Nationally Certified Teacher of Music in Piano through the Music Teachers' National Association. She is a past president of the Kansas Music Teachers' Association (state affiliate of MTNA) and holds active membership in several professional organizations. Her professional credits include multiple appearances at the Piano Texas International Festival and the World Piano Conference, as well as concerts and master classes in Kansas, Missouri, Georgia (USA), the United Kingdom, and Costa Rica. In addition to her university and private studio duties, Dr. Baker-Lampe enjoys ongoing collaborations with pianists and teachers worldwide. These collaborations have led to online recording projects including, most recently, the unpublished 300 Trozos of Guillermo Uribe Holguin (Colombian pianist and composer). Her ongoing collaboration with Argentine composer Sergio René Martinez has resulted in the United States premiers of several of his works.
